Restore Your Services

Restore Disconnected Services Online Through SmartHub!

Customers who are Smarthub users and have been disconnected for non-payment, now have a new feature available. You can pay your bill online and restore services without talking to a customer service representative. Once logged into SmartHub, you would choose a "reconnect" box which automatically adds on restore fees and also submits a restore service order. Your Telephone, Broadband Internet, and TV are able to be restored automatically once payment is made and confirmed. There are some restrictions with this, and depending on what services customers have, this feature may not restore all services until the order has been completed by a CSSR. The restore process can take several minutes for services to be completely activated. This is just another tool to provide more flexibility for the customer.

SmartHub, NCC's Online Customer Portal: SmartHub is the online portal for viewing your current and past bills, pay your bill, report a trouble, and receive notifications.

If you are not a SmartHub user, you can sign up today by going to nccray.com and clicking on Bill Pay. You will need your account information to sign up. Once in SmartHub, you can also select the type of notification you would like to receive including, text messages, emails, and push notifications for the following: suspend for non-pay disconnect, scheduled payments, expired credit cards, declined auto pay. Customers who are not SmartHub users will only receive a letter. SmartHub users will receive an email unless you have gone in to select the notification you prefer. SmartHub can also be downloaded as an app on your smartphone. *NCC Sign up today!

 Factor recovers costs associated with NCC's contributions
 to the federal universal service fund program. Effective
 October 2nd, 2018 and for the 4th quarter of 2018 the
 FUSC contribution factor will increase to 20.1% on your bill.
