NCC Announces CoBank Sharing Success Grant Winners

NCC partnered with CoBank to disperse \$10,000 through the Sharing Success grant program.

Tioga Public School District was awarded \$5,000 to be used to assist the District in expanding the 1:1 computer initiative. Tioga School Superintendent, Carolyn Eide, explains that this initiative is to obtain a 1:1 student to computer/mobile device ratio, with a goal of creating an innovative educational experience by providing that accessibility. The program was implemented in January 2018 with an anticipation of issuing these devices to students in phases until they all have access to one.

The Columbus Fire Department was the recipient of a \$5,000 grant, which will be used to replace a 1960s Ford fire truck that has become unreliable and outdated.

CoBank is a national cooperative bank serving vital industries across rural America. This is a shared grant in which NCC matches what CoBank awards. Entities who can apply must be a 501(c)(3) charity, school or government organization. Past recipients include Ray Fire Department,
