

NOTICE: Channels 80, 81 and 82 on the Advanced TV service for fiber customers, and Channel 17 for RF Cable TV customers, are no longer available.

- Channel 80 had a local weather service that is no longer available to any TV provider, such as NCC. There are several other options to receive local weather on TV including:
 - Channel 12 Community Channel the most local weather including current temp, wind, forecast and today's high/low in the left corner continuously and in center area.
 - Channel 9 KX Weather channel continuous local and regional weather from the KX Storm Team.
 - Channel 12 The Weather Channel national, state and local weather. Also, has Local on the 8's where it rotates through local weather.
- Channel 81 was rebroadcasting the community channel that is on the RF system because at the time that we converted to the new TV system Advanced TV the new community channel was not up and running. It is now available and can be found on Channel 12.
- Channel 82 was local church services. The interest from viewers and the churches has become minimal and the equipment is very out-dated. Because of the decline in attraction to this channel, a replacement for the equipment would be insignificant.
- Channel 17 on the RF Cable TV system is no longer available for the same reason as Channel 82 (above).



- View your current and history of statements and payments.

- Sign up for a one-time \$10 credit to your bill.
- Select how you would like to receive notifications from NCC for important information such as outages, bill reminder and in the future to report a service related trouble.
